Volunteer Contract

H.A.R.T. operates entirely on volunteer time and commitment and as such is dependent on daily communication between all volunteers. Any and all concerns should be shared with the volunteer coordinator, from scheduling conflicts to animal health and safety.

Please read and initial the following:

_____ I understand that this is a volunteer position, however if I am unable to make my assigned shift I will do my best to notify the volunteer coordinator as

soon as possible. I will also do my best to notify the volunteer coordinator if I am running late.

_____ I understand that the policies in place concerning cleaning, feeding and transport are to protect the health and welfare of both me and the animals in the care of H.A.R.T. and I will follow them as written.

_____ I understand that some days I may be the first person to interact with an animal in the care of H.A.R.T. and it is my responsibility to note any abnormal behavior and communicate this to the volunteer coordinator. This includes signs of sickness (diarrhea, wheezing, non-responsiveness, not eating), trauma, worrisome behavior and fleas.

_____ I understand that the animals surrendered to H.A.R.T may need some time to adjust to their new surroundings and I will respect each animals space.

_____ If I am injured while volunteering at the H.A.R.T. facility I will notify the volunteer coordinator immediately. If I am with a volunteer who is injured while at the H.A.R.T. facility and unable to notify the volunteer coordinator, then I will call in their place. If medical attention is needed I will notify the volunteer coordinator and seek appropriate help.
